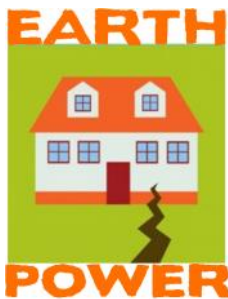


Join us in July for Summer Weather Camp as we explore the POWER that comes from our sun, our earth and our oceans.
