

Join us on Saturday, May 2 for adventure, learning and fun in the home of Punxsutawney Phil, the Weather Capital of the World -Punxsutawney!

Punxsutawney Phil's Weather Extravaganza begins at 10 a.m. and ends at 2 p.m. Scouts & adults will start the day at the Weather Discovery Center then head to Gobblers Knob for Iunch and more fun! Here's what you'll do:

- * Start at the **Weather Discovery Center** at **10 a.m.** then head up to **Gobblers Knob** at **noon** for lunch and the rest of your day. (Lunch includes pizza, vegetable sticks, and fruit.)
- * Explore and interact with the weather science and weather folklore exhibits at the Punxsutawney Weather Discovery Center. Plus you'll make a SWAPS to take home!
- Take a walking tour of some of the Phantastic Phils! Public Art sculptures, take pictures with the
 6-foot-tall creatively-designed Phils and get insider information about them.
- * Granola bars provided as a mid-morning snack.
- * Take a stroll along the Gobblers Knob walking trail and learn about the tradition of Groundhog Day.
- * Meet Punxsutawney Phil and learn about groundhogs.
- * All Girl Scout registrants get a Extravaganza fun patch and a groundhog souvenir!
- * Adults & siblings cost is \$16 and does *not* include the patch and the souvenir.

Important Things to Know:

- Dress for the weather! In spring it might be chilly and rainy, or it could be warm and sunny.
- Wear good walking shoes. During the tour of the Phantastic Phils, you'll walk about three city blocks. On the Gobblers Knob walking trail, you'll walk about 1/2-mile on a woodland path.

- * There is plentiful free parking at Gobblers Knob. There is limited free parking in a lot on the north side of the Weather Discovery Center. There is metered street parking and a parking lot within a block of the center. The metered parking is free on Saturdays in Punxsutawney.
